Tasting Notes

Light pink in color. Aromas of melon, strawberry, radish and spice. A medley of flavors emerge from this dry Rhone style rose'. Bright strawberry and cherry with classic black pepper and musk from the Mourvedre. Full-bodied, this is a hedonistic and intriguing Washington interpretation of a classic rose' from the Southern Rhone.

Technical Notes

Blend: 38% Cinsault 29% Syrah 24% Grenache 6% Mourvedre

Vinification

The various lots of red Rhone varietals were crushed and destemmed to individual tanks. Each varietal was quickly saigned at about 10%, before too much color was allowed to soak up, and fermented to near dryness. The components were then blended to a neutral French barrel to complete fermentation and elevage (aging) on full lees. No Malolactic fermentation is allowed. Lightly fined and sterile filtered prior to bottling.
